Queen Victoria School is a co-educational fully Boarding School funded by the Ministry of Defence to educate some 270 children of Service Personnel. The School is set in 45 acres of beautiful Perthshire countryside and offers stable and uninterrupted boarding education for 10 – 18 year olds. On the retirement of the current incumbent after many years of devoted service to the School, the post of Deputy Head (Pastoral & Guidance) has become available.

This key residential position requires a full commitment to Boarding School life, and includes taking the leading responsibility for the pastoral and boarding life of the School. The Deputy Head (Pastoral & Guidance) is the key link between the School and external agencies such as the Care Inspectorate/SCSWIS, the Scottish Social Services Council (SSSC) and others. Previous experience of boarding is essential, and a qualification in Pastoral Care and a full clean driving licence are desirable.

Applications are invited from well qualified graduates with proven management experience relevant to the post. They should be sound communicators, who can also demonstrate good leadership, teambuilding and time management skills. It is desirable that applicants should be, or be eligible to be, GTC Scotland registered. A requirement of the post will be PVG registration. *Please note: Registration with SSSC is a future requirement for this position and any successful candidate will be required to obtain registration once appointed if not GTC registered.*

Salary is based on SNCT Agreements. A generous allowance is included to reflect the Senior Management Team responsibilities; these include a rota system for evening and weekend duties. This post attracts the full pastoral holiday package and, as it is a residential position, a 3-bedroom detached house is provided within the grounds for which a nominal rent will be charged.
